Last year, the organization helped more than 1,400 adults with one-to-one tutoring and classes and 350 low-income preschool children with early literacy programs. ALL's services touch the lives of students in Orange, Seminole and Osceola Counties, many of whom read at or below a 5th grade level when first joining the program.
- As a profession built upon reading and writing, it is a natural response for the legal community to do what we can to promote volunteerism, raise funds and increase awareness for literacy. The main goal of the Adult Literacy League is to provide our neighbors with the basic skills necessary to navigate and improve their own lives and to insure their children can do the same.
